An individual may not submit a nomination on behalf of himself or herself.

To nominate a member, please send the following:

1. a letter of nomination that includes the nominee's name and address, present position, role in the foreign language profession and MFLA, capacity in which the nominator has know the candidate, and detailed evidence of the ways in which the candidate meets the criteria for the award (not to exceed one page),
2. evidence of the nominee's acceptance of the nomination,
3. a biographical profile which may include education, employment, professional memberships/activities, honors (not to exceed three pages),
4. one letter of recommendation (may submit up to three letters) by someone other than the nominating individual (each letter not to exceed one page).

AMOUNT OF AWARD:

There are one-time awards of \$300.00 for up to three students for the 2010 – 2011 academic year.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

To be eligible, an applicant must:

1. Attend a Mississippi institution of higher learning during the fall term, 2010,
2. Have an A average in foreign language courses,
3. Have studied the same foreign language at least two years in high school, and
4. Be recommended by a teacher who is currently a member of MFLA.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

The application packet must be postmarked on or before May 30, 2010. The recipient(s) will be announced at the Business Meeting at the Annual Conference of MFLA and published in MFLA's *Mississippi Language Crusader*.

PROCEDURE:

An applicant must:

1. Complete and return the 2010 Student Scholarship Application Student Data Form,
2. Submit a letter of recommendation from a teacher who is currently a member of MFLA,
3. Submit a copy of his/her high school transcript (and community college transcript, if applicable), and
4. Submit a 200-word essay in English. The topic is included on the student data form.
